BIO SKETCH – Isak Nti Asare

Isak is the Assistant Director of the Cybersecurity and Global policy program and the Language Workshop at Indiana University’s Hamilton Lugar School of Global and International Studies. He also holds an Adjunct faculty position at HLS. His course on “Artificial Intelligence and Global Policy” will be offered in Fall 2020. Before coming to IU, Isak advised national and local governments on public policy for emerging technologies. For example, Isak is author of Mexico’s National AI strategy, Stockton, California’s AI strategy, and Mexico’s fintech and open banking strategy, and is one of 3 founding members of the cross-governmental community of practice for artificial intelligence in the United Kingdom.
