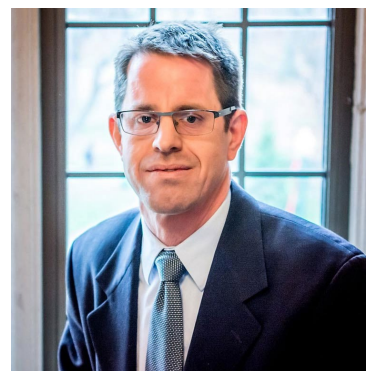

Timothy Hellwig, Ph.D., is Professor of Political Science, Academic Director of the IU [Europe Gateway](#), and previously the Director of the Institute for European Studies, IU Hamilton Lugar School of Global and International Studies. He has been a researcher at the International Foundation for Election Systems, faculty member at the University of Houston, and visiting researcher at the Australian National University, Gothenburg University, and University of Essex. His interests are in comparative political economy, political behavior, European politics, public policy, and research methods. He is a member of the [Executive Approval Project](#), a cross-national effort at compiling and analyzing aggregate public opinion data. Hellwig is coauthor of [Democracy Under Siege? Parties, Voters, and Elections after the Great Recession](#) (Oxford University Press), author of [Globalization and Mass Politics: Retaining the Room to Maneuver](#) (Cambridge University Press), and author of articles in several journals and book chapters, including the *American Journal of Political Science*, the *British Journal of Political Science*, and the *Journal of Politics*.
